The Spine Institute provides continuity of care not previously offered in Redding and unparalleled in the region. The Spine Institute shall maintain personal and compassionate care specific to the unique needs of those with neck and back conditions.

The catchment area for The Spine Institute is currently 570,000 and growing. A 4,500 home, 3,500 acre planned senior community is currently being developed in south Redding. This will significantly increase the demand for many health care services. The payer mix is predominantly private insurance with provider networks including Blue Cross, Blue Shield etc., there is no HMO managed care.

Redding (our primary market) and our secondary catchment areas are serviced by five acute care hospitals; Feather River Hospital in Paradise, Enloe Medical Center in Chico, St. Elizabeth's Community Hospital in Red Bluff, and in Redding, Shasta Regional Medical Center and Mercy Medical Center (a level II trauma center). Redding also has a comprehensive in-patient rehabilitation hospital, Northern California Rehabilitation Hospital. The Redding facilities are all within three miles of our office.

We have a beautiful state of the art medical office building that was designed specifically for our use and is in a highly visible and easily accessible location. Shasta Orthopaedics & Sports Medicine has a successful physician owned out-patient surgery center, Apogee Outpatient Surgery Center, attached to the medical office building. Apogee Outpatient Surgery Center specializes in orthopaedics, pain management and ENT.
